Responsibilities: Reporting to the Patient Care Manager of Ambulatory Services, the Nurse Continence Advisor (NCA) is responsible for and is an expert in the assessing, planning and implementing a plan of care for women experiencing incontinence and Uro/Gyne-related medical concerns. The NCA independently triages patients referred to the clinic, assesses and recommends the most appropriate modality to address the incontinence and implements the plan of care and monitors the effectiveness of the treatment and follow up.

#### Qualifications:

Graduate of a recognized Nursing program required; BScN preferred.

Active registration with the College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta (C.A.R.N.A) required.

Current Heart and Stroke Foundation B.L.S. (Level C) Healthcare Provider Certificate required.

Three to five years experience in Uro/Gyne nursing, Labour and Delivery or Obstetrics preferred.

Candidates must have experience in and a passion for nursing, related to women's health issues.
